Changes to Latest Draft

- Expanded discussions of SWAT, WASP, and QUAL2E
- “Softened” language regarding major sources of Phosphorus and Sedimentation.
- Added new Information and Outreach Plan developed by I&O Workgroup and Texas AgriLife Extension Service.
- Shortened Executive Summary.
- Limited redundant tables and figures.
- Revised BMP descriptions to become consistent with NRCS standards.

- Stakeholder revisions to current draft due March 13th, 2009.
- Next stakeholder meeting (April 2009): New draft available
- Summer 2009: Final draft of WPP
- September 2009: Final revisions
- October 2009: Plan submitted to EPA for approval
